

Welcome to the Avondale House Virtual Tour. We will begin by taking a stroll through the day school!

Upon entering the modern, brightly colored building, you will see a reception desk to your left and a waiting area to your right. The walls are yellow and beige with large windows. The colors were chosen to be subdued as to not be over-stimulating for our students.

As you walk through the burnt orange double doors, you are entering the Day School. As you walk down the hall, you will see hallways on your left. The first hallway contains administrative offices in addition to the nurse's office. The second hallway begins the first row of classrooms. Let us explore the first hallway of classrooms.

As we enter the classroom, you will notice student workspaces and classroom décor. Our classrooms are designed to accommodate up to 8 students with 3 staff members- 1 certified special education teacher and 2 paraprofessionals. Each classroom has its own bathroom along with state-of-the-art technology like Smart Boards. The walls are beige, and the windows are high on the wall to limit distractions and over-stimulation.

As we continue our tour, you will notice a water fountain and beige, metal school lockers on your left. We will also pass two more hallways where 7 additional classrooms are located. We will continue towards the burnt orange double doors and pass two more single stall bathrooms. As we walk through the double doors, we are heading into the multi-purpose room. The room is big and open to accommodate recreation, assemblies, and other group activities. The room is beige with 3 garage doors that open when the weather is nice.

Let's head out the beige double doors to the playground. The playground is very colorful and inviting. Upon first walking out, you will notice a red basketball court with tables. Next, there is a colorful playset with a red slide. The playground has a lot of green trees and is surrounded by a black fence. This concludes the day school portion of the tour, however, you are welcome to hit the back arrow to keep browsing the school.

Alright, let's head up-stairs to explore the adult day habilitation area. Navigate to the #2 option on the right-hand navigation bar. The second floor is home to Avondale's adult day program, also known as day-hab.

Upon entering the second floor, you will find yourself in one of our adult day habilitation training rooms. The room has tables and chairs with brightly colored decorations. Going into the hallway, you will see a row of lockers where the day-hab clients keep their belongings during the day.

We will continue down the hallway to the right and enter the next training room. In this room, you will notice a kitchen area with brown cabinets and white appliances. There is also a wooden table where clients gather to eat. This is where our participants learn how to make meals and eat together every day. Heading back out to the hallway to the right, you will pass two water fountains. Continue down the hallway and you will come to the recycling center on your right. You will notice the grey sorting bins and sorting stations. This is where our clients work to sort the agency's recyclables. After that, they take the recyclables to a local recycling center.
