Avondale House Weathers the Winter Storm

We can all agree that last week's weather was very unusual for everyone in Houston. We are so thankful for our awesome facilities and residential teams who kept everyone safe and warm.



"Prior to the event, our facilities

team prepped Avondale House, including the 4 group homes, making sure that pipes were wrapped and prepared to undergo the freezing temperatures", said Chief Operating Officer, Patti Kelly. But that wasn't all; as the power outages began, two of the generators at the group homes did not start, yet facilities team members travelled through the weather conditions to fix them. "Our newest group home has not yet been equipped with a whole house generator, so the team also got us set up with a portable generator and kept it going throughout the weather event, which meant that they had to find gas and keep it filled while there was no power", continued Kelly.

Many of our group home staff agreed to do "ride out" shifts, which means they work straight through the weather event. "The residential homes truly are a family; without the selflessness of the residential team, we couldn't have maintained the consistency and routine that our residents depend on during the storm", said CEO Steve Vetrano. Thanks to everyone who made last week as smooth as possible!

Avondale's fourth house was recently opened, and we need to purchase a whole-house generator that will keep our residents and staff safe when we have severe weather, like the winter

storm that occurred last week.
