



Update: Avondale House Closures

To our families, friends, and partners,

We are currently experiencing unprecedented circumstances, as we all abide by the social isolation guidelines to prevent the spread of the Coronavirus. Our main concern at this time is the health and well-being of our students, clients, their families, and our team members and their families. In consulting with our local school districts and state and local authorities, we have decided that:

- Avondale House Day School will be closed until further notice. Most of the school districts we serve have taken similar actions. We will monitor the situation daily with our school districts, TEA, local, and state authorities.
- Avondale House Day Habilitation is currently closed to all participants until further notice.
- Avondale Residential program will remain fully operational, but with certain measures focusing on health and safety of our residents and team members.
- Our administrative offices will be open from 10:00 am – 2:00 pm until further notice.
- While routine and consistency is important to the individuals that we serve, we also must consider the safety and well-being of all our participants and their families, visitors and our staff. We are closely monitoring the CDC, Texas Department of State Health Services, TEA, and City of Houston websites for information, and will follow their guidance.

This is a rapidly evolving, fluid situation, and we will provide additional updates as we know more. We are very fortunate to have such supportive partners and dedicated team members as we work through these challenging times.
